

Set up flights in MSFS

Select all weather files (.WPR) and copy them to:

C:\Users\Owner\AppData\Local\Packages\Microsoft.FlightSimulator_8wekyb3d8bbwe\LocalState\Weather\Presets.

Select all Flight Plan files (.PLN) and copy them to any folder that you can easily access.

To set up a flight:

- Start MSFS until you have the Globe active.
- Choose the plane you want to use and set fuel and payload (see flight description)
- Double click on spacebar (the LOAD/SAVE FLIGHT FILES opens), choose: Load from this PC. Browse to the folder where you have stored the Flight Plans (.PLN) and select the right flight plan. Hit open. Select the runway (see flight description).
- Hit FLIGHT CONDITIONS
Under WEATHER AND TIME (left) select CUSTOM.
Under WEATHER AND TIME (right side) set Time and Date (see flight description).
Under WEATHER select from the pull down menu the relevant weather file.
- Close the window and FLY.

Note: If you missed some steps, you can also adjust everything while being on the runway by selecting Weather or Fuel from the top pop-up menu.
